#### LIVING & KITCHEN

16 Wood Street boasts a whole range of superior features which make it noticeably distinct from other city centre properties.

A well-sized living area can be found on the third floor. This superb space is split with a bi-folding door which leadsout to the first roof garden and creates a lounge area and social space unlike anything else in Manchester.

The lower ground floor offers a large, stunning open-plan kitchen and dining area. The kitchen features integrated appliances and a separate island to provide further space for cooking, eating and entertaining as desired. This room leads through to a large utility space complete with separate boiler room.

The centrepiece of this town house is the lounge with its double height ceiling complete with giant cargo net hammock above which provides residents with a unique relaxation space and an unmistakable wow factor.

With a huge, set-piece window along the length of the room, the extremely spacious master bedroom is flooded with natural light. The bedroom leads onto a glamorous walk-in wardrobe equipped with plenty of storage space. The generously-sized second double bedroom boasts a similarly vast window and a fashionable, refined design which creates an air of natural light, luxury and comfort.

On the ground floor you'll find a large and versatile room. Perfect for either a third bedroom or an office if required, it can also be accessed via a separate entrance.

### LOCATION


16 Wood Street is located in the heart of the city's business and retail districts, and its most popular restaurants, bars, shops and cultural hotspots are right on the doorstep.

#### CONNECTIVITY

Manchester Piccadilly Station can be found a short walk away from 16 Wood Street, providing travel options around Manchester and the rest of the UK.

As well as offering easy connections to the rest of the city via the Metrolink tram service, Piccadilly Station provides direct trains to cities and top destinations across the UK, London, Edinburgh, York, the Peak District, the Lake District and more are an easy train away. The journey to the capital city will be reduced to an hour once the new HS2 high speed rail line is completed.

For those who wish to travel further afield, life at 16 Wood Street means you are only ever a 30-minute train journey from Manchester Airport which flies to more than 200 destinations around the world, from New York to Shanghai and everywhere in between.






